*From Father Chuck's Desk...This week we listen to the Gospel story of Christ's first miracle of His public ministry at the wedding feast in Cana. Jesus teaches us that these miracles are signs for us of the Kingdom of God. This saving message is more important than any miracle, of course. The wine didn't last more than a few days and we don't hear anything else about the couple who married or the guests at this celebration. What we do know is that for a simple gathering of people lacking something for a feast, an overabundance of excellent wine was provided. The six jars holding as much as thirty gallons of water, each filled to the brim, were able to provide for all of the needs of the people. The message of this miracle as a sign of the Kingdom of God is that, like the miracle of the loaves and the fish, there will be no need of any kind in God's Kingdom. We are invited to take the message of the Good News of God's Kingdom out into our world. The way we do this is by taking advantage of our unique personal opportunities to meet those who might be surrounded by stingy, selfish people living as if their worldly possessions are their only hope with the spiritual refreshment of our generosity. We need to visibly communicate what our faith tells us. We belong to the Kingdom of God. All we have and all we are is a gift from God to be shared, cared for, and used for God's glory. More importantly, we must live in a way that demonstrates to others that all our worldly possessions and concerns are beneath our primary treasure which is our relationship with God and our eternal place in the Kingdom. May the Holy Spirit bless us as we ask in daily prayer for the strength to give witness to our greatest treasure.*
