From Father Chuck's Desk...Most of the important experiences of our lives are probably "our fault". How we invest our energy into what we really want to happen creates the wealth of memories and attitudes that permeate our lives, whether we are in the midst of happy times or struggles. We are unwise to overlook the ways that we are intimately connected to each other. Few people are "to blame" for most of the events of our lives. Using our blessings for God's glory and to our spiritual benefit is a choice we are called to make, but we can—and sometimes sadly do—choose alternatives with negative consequences. Our happiness can be shared and our struggles can be supported when we maintain strong ties with family and friends. Most importantly, we gain the assurance of God's presence in our lives when our connection to God is strong because of our choice to pray and to be a part of the sacramental life of the Church. Almighty God is the Creator of Heaven and Earth, but because of freedom God wants us to have God's need to become greater in each of our hearts every day by our choice to beckon Him in. Blaming others or God for problems in our lives is probably as inaccurate as it is unproductive. If we have problems with important relationships with family or friends we have the opportunity to look critically at how our actions and words have contributed to them. If we do not like the circumstances of our life we probably have the ability to improve them at least in a few small important ways. God has given us a holy purpose that our lives can fulfill. The joy and peace of being in right relationship with God and one another has to be more valuable to us than being "right" or "evening the score". Striving to overcome our weaknesses and faults is the only way to grow. We can choose the lazy alternative to this work, but we will have only ourselves to blame for the lingering regret that will surely accompany it. May our recollection of God's mercy and patience with us throughout our lives help us to see our blessings clearly, cherish them joyfully, and share them generously so that we may be holy and happy.
