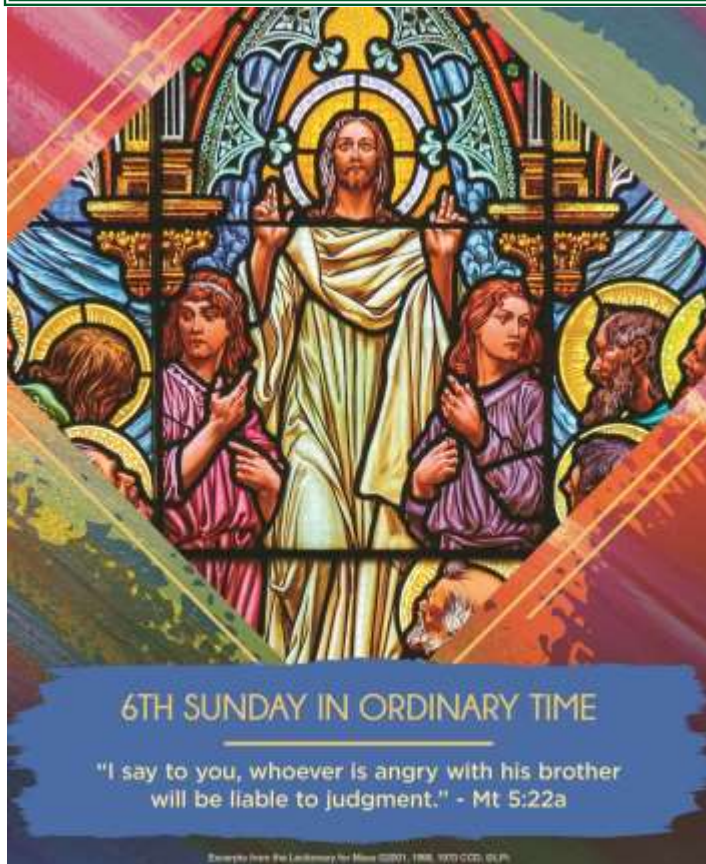

KNOW HIM: The Last Supper and the Gift of the Eucharist set March 9 at Christ Our Shepherd Center, Greensburg

Registration is now open for **KNOW HIM: The Last Supper and the Gift of the Eucharist**, set for Thursday, March 9, at 2 and 6 p.m. at Christ Our Shepherd Center, Greensburg. This experiential event begins with a prayer service led by Bishop Larry J. Kulick, followed by a keynote address and a journey through the rooms at Christ Our Shepherd Center for an unforgettable Eucharistic journey to encounter mysteries of the Eucharist through a life-sized print of Leonardo da Vinci's Last Supper mural created by Italian Renaissance artist Leonardo da Vinci with recorded explanation by internationally-known art historian Liz Lev; Msgr. Michael J. Begolly discussing his recent pilgrimage to the Holy Land and preparing to receive the Eucharist; and a discussion and demonstration about the significance of washing feet given by Fr. Christopher Pujol. Bishop Kulick himself will discuss the bread of life and the symbolism of Easter bread while guests sample paska bread. Talk #1 Born From Above

This presentation will unpack our Lord's conversation with a Scholar of the Old Testament Scriptures, Nicodemus, in John chapter three. Despite all his studies, Nicodemus still could not understand the ways of God. Jesus came to help him see that it was impossible to see God's Kingdom because he was lacking something. Come and learn what is missing.

Talk #2 Operating In The Spirit and Faith

This presentation will explain how we are supposed to function when we have been "born from above". Using a bipartite illustration to reveal how man is supposed to work in the Spirit, we will focus on Faith and how a disciple is empowered through the fire of love to trust in Jesus more. Come and see how we are meant to walk with God.

Talk #3 Do This In Remembrance Of Me

This presentation will unpack the Wedding Feast of the Lamb of God that is described in Luke 22:14-20. We will be using Luke's account of the Lord's Supper and compare it to St. Paul's account from 1 Cor. 11:23-26. We will come see the Apostles' understanding of what Jesus meant when he said, "Do this in remembrance of me."

Throughout the month of February, Bishop Kulick is challenging the faithful of the Diocese of Greensburg to offer and seek forgiveness.

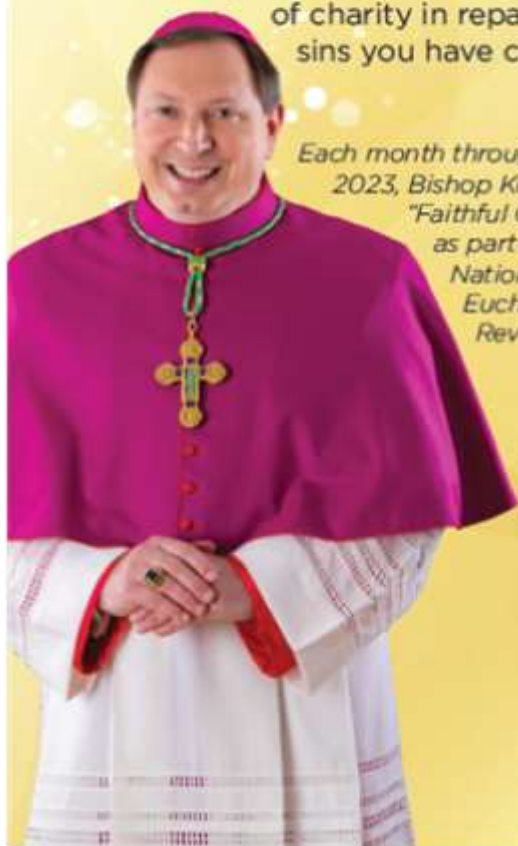

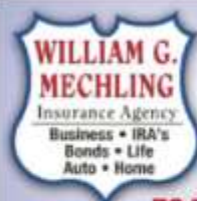
