

From Fr. Matthew's Desk

<u>Congratulations to Fr. Andrew Hamilton</u>—Our Diocese has a new priest this weekend. Fr. Andrew Hamilton was ordained Saturday June 3 at Blessed Sacrament Cathedral. Please keep Fr. Hamilton in prayer as he begins this new phase of his ministry.

10 Years a Priest—As Fr. Hamilton begins his own journey of priesthood, I find myself now a full decade into mine. This is not usually one of the "milestone" anniversaries marked by great celebration, but I am grateful to all of you who have congratulated me on it. The last 10 years have included many events—from the joyous, to the humbling, to the challenging, to the inspiring—but all has been a blessing. Thank you all for having been part of it so far.

<u>Participation in Recent Events</u>—I am so glad that we had a number of parishioners taking part in two recent events. The first was the Last Supper experiential event last weekend. Even though it was on short notice, there were quite a few people who stayed behind to look at the paintings and watch the video. Thank you to Anne Kovalcik for facilitating the setup of the display both here and at St. Bernard School.

The second event was the very well-attended Memorial Day service at Iselin Union Cemetery. I saw many parishioners and friends of the parish in attendance, and several also taking part in the service itself. I am grateful that we had such a strong showing at this community event. It also serves as a reminder that the Iselin cemetery is "our" cemetery, with so many of our past parishioners (in all eras) choosing to be buried there.




