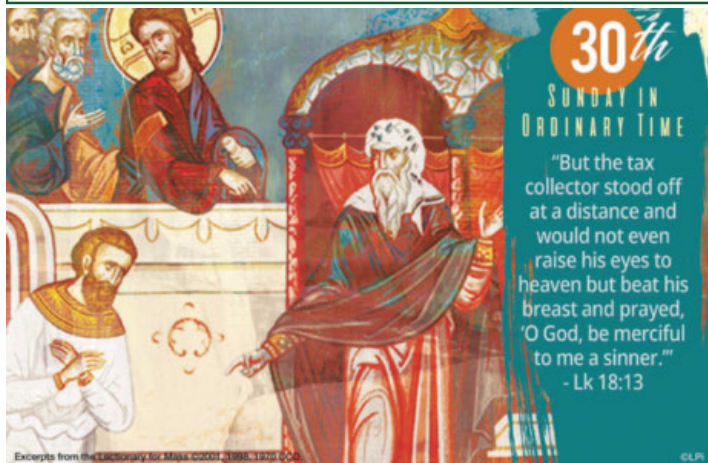

All Saints' Day Masses—Mass for All Saints' Day, a Holy Day of Obligation will be Monday 10/31 at 6PM after Holy Hour, and Tuesday 11/1 at 8:30 AM.
