



**An Updated Note on Masks**—While all children (over 2) and adults are expected to wear masks at Mass for the time being, please remember that common sense dictates how this rule is applied. If you find yourself struggling to breathe while wearing a mask, please do set it aside temporarily and/or step outside to catch your breath. Masks are about promoting *safety* and allowing others to *feel safe*, but it is also important that these *same masks don’t undercut the safety of those wearing them*.
