New Deanery Structure for Diocese—The following news was recently announced for the Diocese of Greensburg:

Bishop Larry J. Kulick is pleased to announce to you a new deanery structure for the Diocese of Greensburg. Effective November 1, 2021 there are seven Deaneries across the Diocese. These seven Deaneries replace both the ten existing regions and the five existing Deaneries. This new structure was announced to the Clergy at their Convocation on October 20, 2021. It is Bishop Kulick's hope that this revised structure will serve to advance the Mission of Jesus Christ in a way that more closely corresponds to the needs of our Diocese at this time.

Bishop Kulick also believes it is his responsibility, as Chief Shepherd of the Diocese of Greensburg, to establish a leadership structure that nurtures growth and engages our younger clergy in that process. To that end, you will notice two new names on the list of Deans; Fr. Eric J. Dinga and Fr. Tyler J. Bandura. These two men will join the five other Deans to be the Bishop's representative in their specific deanery.

While this is noteworthy for everyone's awareness, in practice it will not change many things for us at the parish. Our new Deanery will be **Deanery II**, which encompasses all of Indiana County except for Saltsburg, and also includes Seward (on the Eastern edge of Westmoreland County). Our Dean continues to be **The Very Rev. James B. Morely, VF**, Pastor of Church of the Resurrection in Northern Indiana County. The new Deanery is essentially identical to our old Region, which was part of a very large Deanery that included most of Armstrong County. This means we will continue to work with nearby parishes for Penance Services and other events as we had done in the past.

The Deans, also called *Vicars Forane*, serve in an oversight role over parishes, as well as an advisory role for the Bishop. Deans will visit parishes occasionally to double-check that books and facilities are in good order; they serve as administrators of a parish in the event of the pastor being incapacitated or otherwise unable to carry out his office; they also serve as members of the Presbyteral Council and Council of Consultors that advise the Bishop in important matters of diocesan governance.

Construction Update #4—This is a more modest update than previous ones, mostly because the sign of success is an *absence*. The DeMaria house, garage, and boathouse have been removed. Final cleanup, grading, and seeding is still underway. Thank you to Dave Galinac of Dig-All Excavating for all your hard work, and your quick demolition of these buildings.
