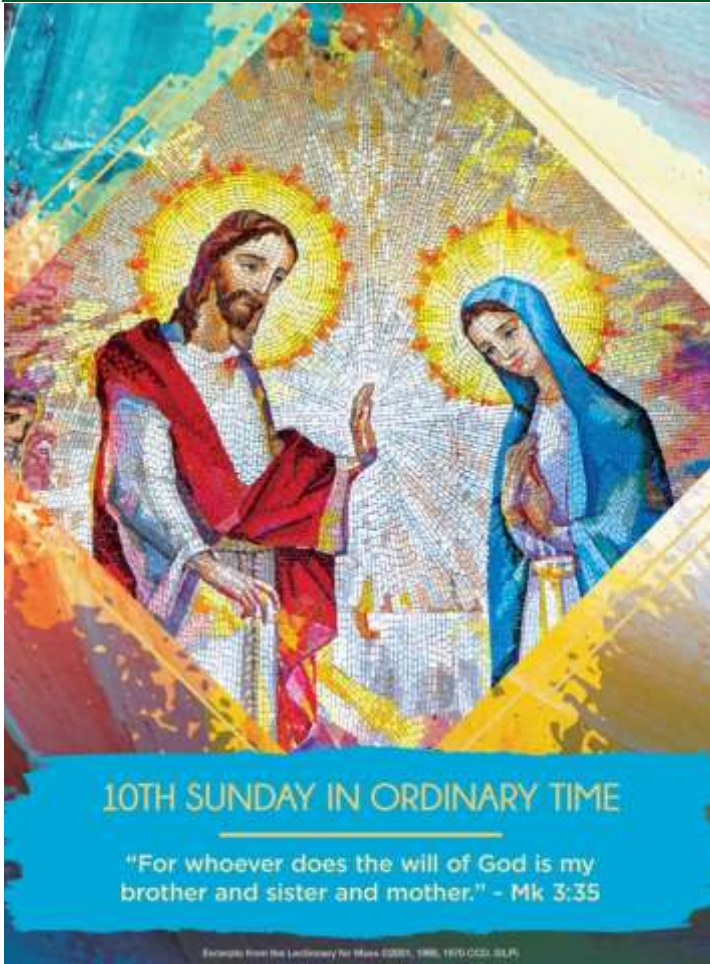

From Fr. Dino's Desk

Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time
Reflection

June 9. Texts: Genesis 3:9-15, Psalm: 130:1-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8, 2 Corinthians 4:13 - 5:1, Mark 3:20-35.

Spiritual Blindness. In our effort to be protective we can at times become possessive and hinder others from carrying out their own mission and ministry. This seems to have happened to the family of Jesus when they heard that Jesus was being deluged and devoured by the crowds even to the point that they could not even eat. Seeing the relentless onslaught of demands being made on Him, they went to seize and save Jesus thinking that He was out of His mind! Little did they understand His pastoral rhythm that made Him reached out to one and all without making any distinction or discrimination. When Jesus served to the sick, the suffering and sinners, He gave Himself without reserve and measure. What an example of consuming zeal Jesus portrays even to the point of putting aside His own personal human needs. Instead of acknowledging and accepting what Jesus was doing with the divine power and authority that was His as God, the scribes ascribe His ministry to Beelzebul, the prince of demons. It is a terrible thing to be blind; to live in a world of darkness. But it is far worse to have eyes and not see. That was sadly the sin of the scribes. They were refusing to see the light and thus sinning against the Holy Spirit. Indeed, you cannot give sight to someone who refuses to see.
